


FACILITIES:

Helica Hip Replacement

Since 2008, we have been performing the new, less invasive Helica hip replacement with excellent results. In 2008, CVSS hosted the first East Coast training seminar for this exciting new procedure. Dr.'s Roa and Weeren have since been invited to serve as instructors for this procedure at the ACVS meeting being held in D.C. Fall 2009.



Arthroscopy

We have provided arthroscopy at our Towson facility since 2005. We have recently added arthroscopy to our services in Annapolis as well.

Stem Cell Therapy

Stem cell therapy aids in the treatment of diseases such as osteoarthritis using the patient's own stem cells to repair damaged cartilage. Cells are harvested from the patient's fat and sent to Vetstem for isolation. After isolation, the cells are returned for immediate use in the patient.

Tibial Tuberosity Advancement (TTA)

In the spring of 2008, we began performing the TTA procedure for patients with cranial cruciate ligament ruptures and have had excellent results. In theory, this procedure is biomechanically superior to the TPLO procedure in most dogs.



Sliding Humeral Osteotomy (SHO)

There are many modern advances in the field of elbow dysplasia treatment. We have surgeons certified in the new SHO procedure for dogs with elbow incongruity and arthritis.



TATE Elbow Replacement

The TATE Elbow Replacement System has many advantages and a much higher success rate than previously available elbow replacement systems. Doctors Prostredny, Roa and Weeren are currently undergoing a rigorous certification program for the new TATE system.



CANINE & FELINE REHABILITATION

We have certified rehabilitation therapists and certified rehabilitation assistants available for our orthopedic and neurologic patients.
