FAQS:

What is a "Surgical Specialist"?

A Surgical Specialist is a veterinarian who has completed 8 years of undergraduate and veterinary schooling, and has undergone four additional years of advanced surgical training. To become Board Certified, candidates must then pass the certification exam administered by the American College of Veterinary Surgeons.

How do I know if my pet needs specialty surgery?

Your primary care veterinarian will usually refer patients to a surgical specialist when a pet requires more advanced diagnostics or surgical treatment for a medical condition than they normally provide.

If I'm referred to Chesapeake Veterinary Surgical Specialists, what do I do? What can I expect?

Call the CVSS location nearest you to schedule an initial consultation. At that time, your pet will be evaluated and diagnostic, surgical and medical options for your pet's condition will be discussed with you.
